Federal Lawsuit Against Axiom Worldwide, Inc and James Gibson is Dismissed by the US Court

On April 13th, 2012, the US Magistrate Judge in Atlanta, Georgia dismissed Axiom Worldwide, Inc and Axiom Worldwide, LLC from the lawsuit with North American Medical. The case was styled *North American Medical vs. Axiom Worldwide, Inc et al*, and was filed in 2006. The lawsuit was a Lanham Act case and was largely based on alleged improper marketing by the collective Axiom defendants.

With the dismissal, all pending claims of the Plaintiff and the Defendants were dismissed and all parties were ordered to bear their respective attorneys' fees and costs. Defendant James Gibson was personally dismissed on October 28th, 2011. However, as a stipulation for this dismissal, Gibson forever waived his right to collect any attorney's fees and, in return, was permanently dismissed from the case individually.
